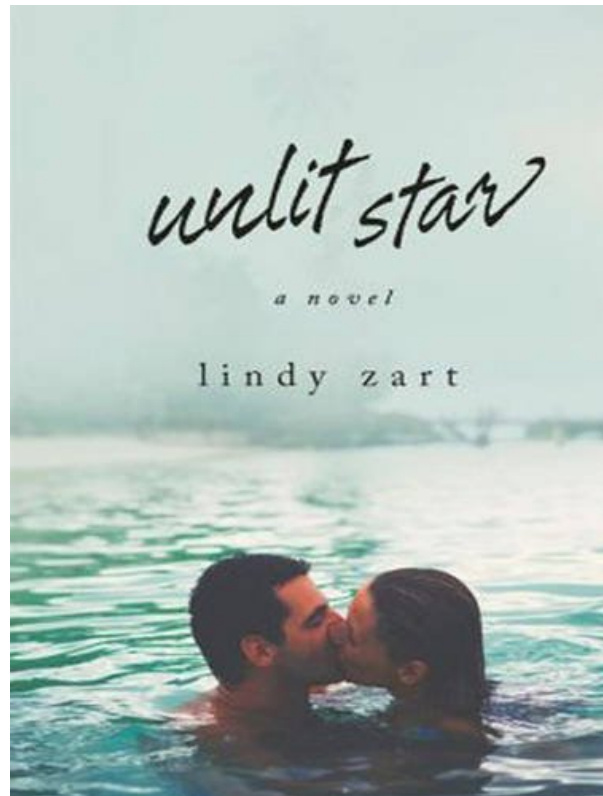
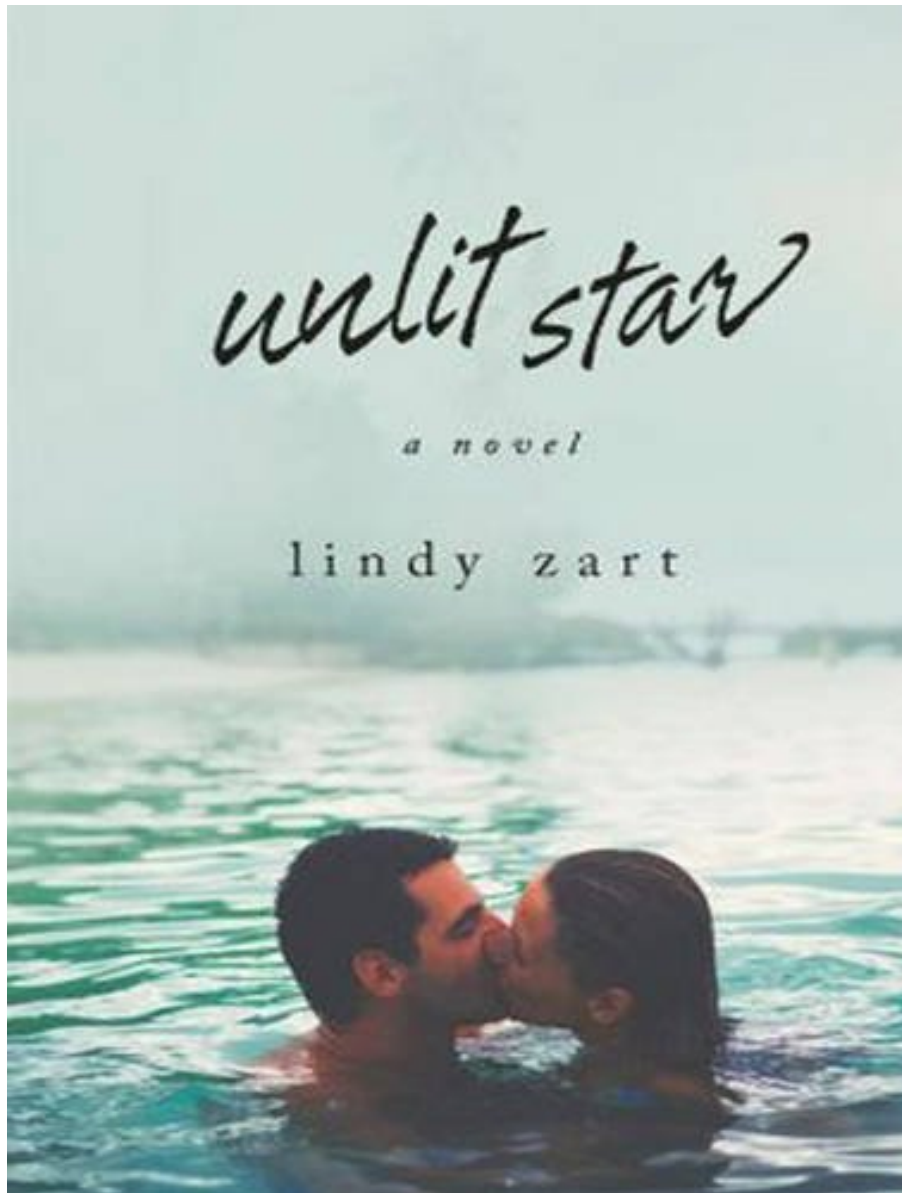

Knowing Rivers is like opening a book of poetry that keeps getting more and more lovely. His harsh tone with Delilah softens as he begins to accept his scarred future. As Delilah helps him realize his potential, and the very convenient living arrangements that force them to talk to each other, Rivers leaves the high school jock behind to become a better person. Even though Delilah had the majority of dialogue, Rivers' words were by far the most jarring.

“Miss you? Yes. Long for you? Yes. I realized something last night, as I laid there without you next to me. All it took was one night.” He pauses. “I don't think there is a question as to whether or not I want you, because that is painfully blatant right now, but did I miss you? It was so much more than that. And do I need you? Yes. I need you. My heart needs you, Delilah. I don't want to wake up without you again, not until I have to. And even then—even then I will just barely tolerate it.”
